## **Interruption Rules**

Discipline – the ability to follow rules even when you think you know a better way Obedience – listening, trusting, and doing what you are told unconditionally 10 Point Questions: If it starts off with "mentions, refers to, speaks of, says, tells us, states that", hit on the next key word. If it has "\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_" near the beginning, hit on the word after "of". If it starts with a question word, hit on the next key word. Otherwise, hit on the question word. 20 point questions: On a 2-part, hit on the 1<sup>st</sup> key word after the 1<sup>st</sup> question. On a "How many \_\_\_ and what are they" question, hit on the \_\_\_\_. If it starts with a question word, hit on the next key word. If it starts with "says what about ..." hit on the next key word. Otherwise, hit on the question word or do/doing/does/did. 30 point questions: On multiple part questions, hit on the 2<sup>nd</sup> question. On 2-part cross reference, hit after the 1<sup>st</sup> part and the 2<sup>nd</sup> reference. These can be hard, but your coach will try to cover most possibilities with you. **GOD'S WORD:** Learn it. Live it.
